Application Information

- Resident of Indiana at the time of entry into the college or university
- Majoring in Personnel Management, Industrial Relations, or Business Administration with a Human Resources concentration
- Full-time or part-time student
- Junior, senior or graduate student at the time of application

SELECTION PROCESS

The scholarship is administered by a committee of members appointed by our President. The Committee recommends the recipient's to the Board of Directors, which grants final approval.

- Student's statement of career goals and reasons for choosing a career in human resources management.
